(c) The Government is taking immediate steps to relieve shortages and all requisite steps to maintain price stability some of which are as given below: -

li) increase in production- agricultural and industrial—to meet the demand;

(iii) fixation of prices, statutorily or informally;

liii) organisation of public distributive system for essential commodities like foodgrains and milk;

(iv) fair distribution of essential commodities through regulatory controls under the Essential Commodities Act, 1955; and (v) availability of essential commodities through cooperative channels.
