- (a) the reaction of other member countries at the Commonwealth Finance Ministers' Conterence held in Bahamas in September, 1971, to his statement to the effect that the Organisations like World Bank should not be instrumental in furthering the commercial and political interests of the prosperous countries; and
- (b) the reaction of the Ministers of Finance of other member-countries to his statement to the effect that the influx of refugees from Bangla Desh has burdened the developmental Budget of India by twenty per cent and whether any of these countries has since agreed to give any financial help?]

वित्त मन्त्री (श्री य० ब० चव्हाण) : (क) सितम्बर, 1971 को सम्पन्न राष्ट्रमण्डल के वित्त मंत्रियों की बैठक में अपने भाषण में, मैने विश्व वेंक की कुछ नीतियों पर फिर से यिचार करने की आवश्यकता की ओर ध्यान दिलाया था और इस सम्बन्ध में चेतावनी दी थी कि बहपक्षी संस्थाएं समद्ध सदस्यों के वाणिज्यिक और राज-नीतिक हितों को आगे बढ़ाने का माध्यम बनती जा रही हैं। कुछ अन्य विकासशील सदस्य देशों ने भी विश्व वैंक की नीतियों पर फिर से विचार करने की आवश्यकता पर जो दिया था। बैठक मे अन्त में जारी की गयी विज्ञप्ति में भी मन्त्री के विचारों का आभास मिलता है कि बैक समृह अपनी कुछ नीतियों पर उपयोगी ढंग से फिर से विचार करेगा और इसमें यह आशा व्यक्त की गई है कि उस प्रकार के पूर्निचार के परिणामस्वरूप ऋणों और उनके भगतानों में तेजी आयेगी और पहले से अधिक देशों को ऋण उपलब्ध हो सकेंगे।

(ख) मैने, भारत की मौजूदा आर्थिक स्थिति के संदर्भ में बांगला देश से आये शरणार्थियों से उत्पन्न स्थिति का उल्लेख किया था। चूकि शरणार्थियों का मामला विषय-सूची में शमिल नहीं था, इसलिए बैठक में सहायता के सम्बन्ध में कोई औपचारिक प्रस्ताव प्राप्त नहीं था। फिर भी राष्ट्रमण्डल के कई देशों ने शरणार्थियों के लिए सहायता की पंगकण की है।

†[THE MINISTER OF FINANCE/विस मंत्री (SHRI Y.B. CHAVAN) : (a) In my address to the Commonwealth Finance Ministers' meeting in September, 1971, I sought to focus attention on the need to review some of the policies of the World Bank and in this connection warned about the danger of multilateral institutions becoming instruments for the pursuit of the commercial and political interests of the richer members. Some of the other developing member-countries also stressed the need for a review of the policies of the World Bank. The communique issued at the and of the meeting also conveyed the feeling of the Ministers that the Bank group might usefully review a number of their policies and hoped that such a review would result in speeding up of loans and disbursements as well as in making loans available to a larger number of countries.

(b) I referred to the situation arising out of Bangla Desh refugees in the context of the current economic conditions in India. As the subject of refugees was not on the agenda, no formal offers of help were made as the meeting. However, several Commonweal h member-countries have offered assistance for the refugees.]

So far orders for 1696 items have been placed totalling a value of about Rs. 22 crores. The number of items and the list of names of firms being large, the time and labour involved in collection and tabulation of the information will not be commensurate with the results likely to be achieved.
