THE MINISTER OF CULTURE (SHRI S. JAIPAL REDDY): The details of proposals/projects received from Kerala Government and funds sanctioned are as under:

2002-2003

- (i) Rs. 2.40 lakhs was sanctioned to Kottarakkara Thampuram Memorial Museum of Classical Art, Kottarakkara P.O., Kolam District, Kerala for Modernisation of Museum.
- (ii) A proposal was also received from Kerala State Science & Technology Museum, Thiruvananthapuram, but the proposal was not recommended for grant by Expert Committee.

2003-2004

- (i) Rs. 1.00 crore was sanctioned to Kerala Government for Construction of Multi-Purpose Cultural Complex at Kerala.
- (ii) Rs. 5.00 lakhs was sanctioned to Guru Gopinath Natana Gramam Society, Vattiyorkvu, Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala for Modernisation of Galleries.
- (iii) Rs. 2.00 lakhs was sanctioned to Government of Kerala for organizing 'Seminar on Classical Dance.

Besides the above, Rs. 15.00 lakhs was provided to support Kudiattam during 2003-2004.

There are two Manuscript Research Centre in Kerala under the National Manuscripts Mission viz. Oriental Manuscripts Library (Kerala University) and Thunchan Memorial Research Centre at Tirur.
