**SUPPLY OF POWER FOR ANDHRA PRADESH
FROM ATOMIC ENERGY STATION AT
KALPAKAM**

700. SHRI SANDA NARAYAN-
APPA : Will the Minister of IRRIGA-
TION AND POWER/ सिचाई और विद्युत्
मंत्री be pleased to state :

(a) whether there is any possibility for Andhra Pradesh to take power from the Atomic Energy Station at Kalpakam in Tamil Nadu;

(b) if so, the quantum of power supply to Andhra Pradesh from the said station; and

(c) whether it would be sufficient to meet the needs of the State by 1973-74 even after the supply of power from the said Station?

**THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE
MINISTRY OF IRRIGATION AND

लक्ष्मी नथ बाजु नाथ (SHRI BAIJ NATH
KUREEL) : (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) Two generating units of 251 MW each are to be set up at Kalpakam. The output from the first unit and 50% of that from the 2nd unit will be utilized in Tamil Nadu. The balance output has been earmarked for other States in the Southern Region including Andhra Pradesh.

(c) The power from the 2nd unit at Kalpakam will be available to Andhra Pradesh only in the Fifth Plan.
