POSTS AND TELEGRAPHS COMMUNICATIONS IN ANDAMANS

- (i) Formation of a separate Postal Division for the administration of the Postal Services on the Islands. This would also enable the islands to be regarded as a separate unit of recruitment for the clerical grades in the Post Office and would obviate the need to bring staff from the mainland.
- (ii) Utilisation of all available steamer services, both passenger and cargo, for conveyance of mails between the mainland and the Islands.
- (iii) Utilisation of sailings of all Government vessels between the various Islands on other duties for conveyance of mails between various post offices.
- (iv) Opening of a floating mobile Post Office on an experimental basis by the inter-Island steamer serving the Southern group of Islands.
- (v) Improvement of the Wireless-Telegraph and Radio links between the mainland and the Islands.
- (vi) Provision of Wireless-Telegraph/ Radio Telephone links for inter-Island communication working between Port Blair
