#### RECOVERY OF PROVIDENT FUND DUES

SHRI BHUPESH GUPTA :

Will the Minister of LABOUR AND REHABILITATION/ श्रम और पुनर्वासि be pleased to refer to the reply I to Unstarred Question No. 917 given in the Rajya Sabha on the 27th November, 1970 and state :

(a) whether a Recovery Committee was set up by the Coal Mines Provident Fund to realise the outstanding dues from the coal mine owners which is increasing every year and if so, the amount of outstanding dues during 1968-69, 1969-70 and 1970-71 (till April);

(b) whether it has been decided to abolish the Recovery Committee and if so, the reasons therefor; and

(c) what progress has been made to realise the outstanding dues from the colliery employers ?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR AND REHABILITATION/ श्रम और पुनर्वासि मंत्रालय में उपमंत्री (SHRI BALGOVIND VERMA) : The administration of the Coal Mines Provident Fund is the concern of the Board of Trustees, Coal Mines Provident Fund and is not the direct concern of the Central Government. The Coal Mines Provident Fund authorities have reported as under :—

(a) The Recovery Committee was set up by the Board of Trustees, Coal Mines Provident Fund in February, 1968. The amount of outstanding Coal Mines Provident Fund dues at the end

of the following years was as shown below :—

(b) The Committee was abolished by the Board of Trustees in December 1970 as most of the defaulting employers who were allowed to pay the Coal Mines Provident Fund dues in instalments by the Recovery Committee failed to pay not only the instalments but also the current dues.

(c) The outstanding dues amounting to Rs. 7,00,21,191/- at the end of 1969-70 were reduced to Rs. 6,87,44,628/- by the end of December 1970.
