include raising the production of edible oilseeds, including that of non-traditional oilseeds like soyabean and sunflower, encouraging the extraction of oil from minor oilseeds and cotton seed, and arranging imports of oilseeds and oils to the extent feasible.

*422. SHRI R. P. KHAITAN : Will the Minister of SUPPLY/पूर्ति मंत्री be pleased to state :

- (a) whether any contract was entered into between Government and the jute mills for the supply of B Twill gunny bags; if so, for how much quantity mill-wise;
- (b) what were terms of the contract and the quantity supplied by the mills during the months of January, 1970 to March 1971; and
- (c) the details of the outstanding deliveries against the mills (mill-wise)?

Tariff Commission.

Government have, however, set up a Billet-Re-rollers' Committee for the purpose of regulating the production and distribution of materials rolled by billet re-rollers. Copies of the relevant notifications outlining the salient features have been given earlier to the House.

The operation of the Billet Rerollers' Committee does not add to steel availability in the country, but increases the proportion available for regulated distribution to priority sectors at regulated prices,
