- (a) whether some countries have imposed restriction on import of Indian honey;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether honey is being imported in the country; and
- (d) if so, the quantum of honey imported during the last five years along with the names of the countries from where it was imported?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY (SHRI E.V.K.S. ELANGO VAN): (a) No, Sir.

(c) Yes, Sir. As per the EXIM Policy natural honey is freely importable.
