Small quantities of steel materials—less than a wagon load —are distributed at regulated uniform prices throughout the stockyards of the main producer, spread over the country. In Ke'rala there is a stockyard each of Hindustan Steel Ltd. and TISCO at Cochin, which cater to the requirements of the actual consumers in Small Scale Sector in that State.

- (a) and (b) Yes, Sir. A Section of the workers were on strike without prior I notice from 15th t<sub>0</sub> 18th March, 1971.
- (c) to (e) After the strike had commenced, a demand was presented by the union of the striking workmen for immediate supply of miner's boots. After j discussions between the representatives of the workers and the local manage-i ment, it was agreed that as miner's boots of the prescribed type were not being presently, manufactured 'Huntertype\* canvas boots might be supplied to them for the present.

LOSSES SUFFERED BY THE NATIONAL COAL DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION

THE MINISTER OF STEEL AND MINES/ इस्पात और खान मंत्री (SHRI S. MOHAN KUMARAMANGALAM)

- (a) The accounts for the year 1970-71 have not yet been finalised. The provi sional estimates indicate a loss of about Rs. 42 lakhs in i970-71 as against the profit of Rs ikhs in 1969-70.
- (b) The production of the National Coal Development Corporation has not d in 1970-71.
- (c) and (d) The performance N.C.D.C. during the year 197 1970-71 year which was an unfavourable year for the coal industry has been fairly satisfactory. The main re:i-:ons for the likely loss in 1970-71 are:
  - (i) increase in cost due to increase in variable dearness allowance and power tariff and higher cost of ma- [ chinery and equipment without corresponding increase in the selling price of coal;
  - (ii) unsatisfactory transport position;
  - (iii) inadequate demand for coal I in as a first star for the the first half of the year.

The Corporation has been endeavouring to reduce costs (a) by increasing i the production and 1969-70 and 1970-71 and and and thereby improving the utilisation of installed capacity anu investment and (b) by quarterly and monthly detailed cost analysis for each colliery.

The Government of India is making every effort to improve the wagon supply to the collieries in the eastern sector by improving the law and order situation in consultation with the State Governments concerned.
