THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT/developmental affairs: (a) and (b). Government are of the view that in the determination of, the prices of industrial goods which require to be fixed in the public interest, such fixation should take due note of the likely cost of production at optimum efficiency in the relevant circumstances and provide for a reasonable return on the capital invested.

APPLICATIONS FOR INDUSTRIAL LICENCES FROM MADHYA PRADESH

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT/developmental affairs: (a) The new Licensing policy was announced on the 18th February, 1970. During the period from 19th February, 1970 to 31st March, 1971, 98 applications were received for grant of industrial licences in respect of Madhya Pradesh.

(b) 13 industrial licences and 7 letters of intent have so far been issued.

(c) 12 applications have been rejected and in 7 cases the applications have been otherwise disposed of (withdrawn/closed, no licence required etc).
