REPRESENTATION FOR CONSTRUCTION OF OVERBRIDGE IN CALICUT CITY

(a) whether Government have received any representation for the construction of a

railway over-bridge over the railway line passing through Calicut City; and

(b) if so, the details thereof and Government's reaction thereto?

THE MINISTER OF RAILWAYS/%1 flair (SHRI K. HANUMANTHAIA) : (a) Yes.

(b) Request was received from the Calicut Corporation in January, 1971 for construction of three road over-bridges in the City during the current financial year. As per existing procedure, proposals for construction of over/under-bridges in replacement of existing busy level crossings are required to be sponsored by the State Government/Road authority together with an undertaking to bear their share of the cost. The Corporation was advised accordingly in February, 1971 to take up the matter with the State Government. As soon as a specific proposal is sponsored by the State Government, the Railway will take appropriate action for the Railway's portion of the work on bridge structure for such of the road overbridges in Calicut City as may be proposed by the State Government.
