- (b) and (c). The matter of improving the performance of Public Enterprises is a continuous one and engages the constant attention of Government. The measures already initiated and directed to effect improvements in the working of Public Enterprises fall under the following three categories:
- (i) Improvements in managerial and operational efficiency;
  - (ii) Diversification of production lines; and
- (iii) Promotion of exports.

Specific measures taken under the above heads are improved investment appraisal, introduction of performance budgeting, internal audit and cost accounting system, reduction of inventories, introduction of modern management techniques, management development and training, etc. The decisions taken in this regard are based, to a large extent, on the recommendations of the Administrative Reforms Commission in their Report on "Public Sector Undertakings", apart from the recommendations made by the Committee on Public Undertakings in their Report on Management" "Materials "Financial Management", as well as on the periodical reviews undertaken by Government on the performance of these enterprises.
