

**ALL INDIA RADIO BROADCAST PRONOUNCING  
GILGIT AS PART OF PAKISTAN**

251. SHRI LOKANATH MISRA : Will the Minister of INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING/सूचना और प्रसारण मंत्री be pleased to state :

(a) whether attention of the Government of India has been invited to a report in the Motherland of 17th February, 1971, to the effect that in the All India Radio news bulletin at 8.15 A. M. on 16th February, 1971, Gilgit was pronounced as part of Pakistan ;

(b) whether till now Gilgit has been treated as part of occupied Kashmir by Pakistan ; and

(c) if so, whether the bulletin shows any change in the Government's policy, and if not, why such broadcast was made ?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING/सूचना और प्रसारण मंत्रालय में उपमंत्री (SHRI DHARAM BIR SINGH) : (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) Gilgit is even now part of Pakistan-occupied Kashmir ;

(c) There has been no change in Government's stand. The reference to Gilgit as part of Pakistan was a mistake. The official concerned has been cautioned to be careful in future.

**STREAMLINING OF POLICE ADMINISTRATION**

(b) if so, whether any proposals have been made by the West Bengal Government to the Central Government in this matter in so far as the Central services like the I. P. S, and the I. A. S. in the State are concerned ?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS/गृह मंत्रालय में राज्य मंत्री (SHRI K. C. PANT) :

(a) and (b) The Government of West Bengal have recently requested the Government of India to return to them some of the I. P. S. officers on deputation to the Government of India and in lieu of those to be returned, they have offered to depute to the Centre some other officers now serving in the State. Exchange of officers between the State and the Centre is an essential element in the management of the Cadre, is a continual process and takes place in the exigencies of service and the special needs of the governments concerned.

Government understand that the State Governments are presently engaged in formulating schemes for further streamlining the police administration in West Bengal.
