### STATEMENT

- (a) The production of saleable steel by the main producers aggregated 4.5 million tonnes in 1970-71, as compared to the rated capacity of 6.73 million tonnes.
- (b)and (c). The Minister of Steel & Mines met the Joint Wage Negotiating Committee on 21st April, 1971. On this Committee, the employers, recognised Union in each plant and the Central Trade Union Organisations are represented. On this occasion the Minister discussed various matters such as production, productivity, industrial relations and the future of the Joint Wage Negotiating Committee and also heard the views of the Members of the Committee. This was in the nature of a meeting where views were exchanged and hence no specific decisions were taken. There was, however, favourable response from all sides to the suggestion that attention must be directed to improve production and productivity.
