

(ii) In order that Civil Police be readily available, the State Governments/Union Territories were requested to open police stations in the premises of airports, with sufficient staff strength.

(iii) Recommendations were made for streamlining the procedure for checking of passengers and their personal baggage.

POWER SUPPLY IN DELHI

185. DR. B. N. ANTANI: Will the Minister of IRRIGATION AND POWER be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the demand for power in Delhi had increased in 1969-70 by eight times as compared to 1952-53;

(b) whether it is a fact that in 1971-72 Delhi would have to share some of its power with neighbouring states:

(c) if so, whether there would be any rationing of power in Delhi; and

(d) what measures are being taken to increase power supply in Delhi?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF IRRIGATION AND POWER (PROF. SIDDHESHWAR PRASAD): (a) The load demand in Delhi has risen from 32 MW in 1952-53 to about 210 MW in 1969-70.

(b) During 1971-72, Delhi is expected to have surplus power to the extent of 45 MW while the neighbouring States of Punjab, Haryana and LT.P. will have power shortages. Thus, Delhi can conveniently give relief to the neighbouring States to a certain extent.

(c) No.

(d) The 5th generating unit of 55 MW at Indraprastha Power Station is in an advanced stage of commissioning and is expected to be in commercial operation within the next two months. One set of 100 MW at Badarpur Thermal Power-station will be commissioned in 1972-73,

followed by second and third units of 100 MW each at intervals of six months thereafter. 20 MW from Baira-Suil H.E. Project and 30 MW from Salal H.E. Project are also expected to be available for Delhi. Integrated operation of Delhi with States in the Northern Region will further strengthen the power supply.

MARKETING OF TEA

186. SHRI J. S. TILAK.: Will the Minister of FOREIGN TRADE be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government of India have decided to appoint a Central Organisation for the marketing of tea at all stages; and

(b) if so, What are the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF FOREIGN TRADE (SHRI L. N. MISHRA): (a) and (b) Yes, Sir, we have a proposal to set up a Tea Corporation. The details of the set up of the proposed Corporation and its functions are being worked out.
