THE MINISTER OF PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS (SHRI MANI SHANKAR AIYAR): (a) Oil & Natural Gas Corporation Limited (ONGC) earned the same amount of dividend of Rs. 186.66 crore from Indian Oil Corporation Ltd. and GAIL (India) Ltd. during the first six months of 2004-05 as during the corresponding period of last year.

(b) Crude oil produced by ONGC during April—September 2004 was 13.282 MMT compared to 12.727 MMT produced during the corresponding period of last year.

(c) ONGC's gross income from operations was Rs. 22497 crore during the first six months of 2004-05 as compared to Rs. 16835 crore during the corresponding period of last year.
