THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION AND SOCIAL WELFARE (SHRI SIDDHA-RATHA SHANKAR RAY) A statement showing the progress of enrolments in professional courses at the University stage is placed on the Table of the House.

The University Grants Commission has approved in principle the proposal of Delhi University to restructure the under-graduate courses to provide for vocational courses as optional subjects 101 this purpose, the University proposes to set up a Institute of Professional Courses whose main functions will be:

- (a) to design and organise the voca tional courses to be offered;
- (b) to evaluate continuously the relevance and success of the different vocational courses offered and make changes when required; and
- (c) to study the employment market and offer guidance to students in the choice of vocational courses.
