(a) The Subsidy Scheme does not provide for any grants for purchase of aircraft. The loan of Government owned Pushpak aircraft to Flying Clubs has not been discontinued.

(b) The total number of Flying Clubs in the country is 25. 788 persons were undergoing flying training at these clubs in February, 1971.

(c) Orders for a total of 147 Pushpak aircraft have been completed by Hindustan Aeronautics Ltd., Bangalore. At present there are no further orders for manufacture of this aircraft.]

VOCATIONAL EDUCATION AT THE COLLEGE AND UNIVERSITY LEVEL

achieved so far in regard to the expansion of vocational and professional education at the college and university level in the country?

THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION AND SOCIAL WELFARE (SHRI SIDDHARATHA SHANKAR RAY) A statement showing the progress of enrolments in professional courses at the University stage is placed on the Table of the House.

The University Grants Commission has approved in principle the proposal of Delhi University to restructure the under-graduate courses to provide for vocational courses as optional subjects. For this purpose, the University proposes to set up a Institute of Professional Courses whose main functions will be:

- to design and organise the vocational courses to be offered;
- to evaluate continuously the relevance and success of the different vocational courses offered and make changes when required; and
- to study the employment market and offer guidance to students in the choice of vocational courses.

The detailed scheme for the establishment of the Institute is being prepared by the University.
