

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI SHRI PRAKASH JAISWAL): (a) to (c) On November 20, 2004 in Narkati jungle area under Naugarh Police Station in Chandauli district, MCCI extremists triggered a landmine blast and opened indiscriminate fire targeting a 3-vehicle convoy of a police party. 15 policemen comprising 10 Provincial Armed Constabulary (PAC) jawans and 5 civil police personnel including a Sub-Inspector were killed in the incident while 2 other policemen were injured. The naxalites decamped with a GF rifle, three AK-47, six SLRs, two 303 rifles and ammunition from the deceased policemen.

(d) and (e) The Central Government had adopted a multi pronged strategy to tackle the problem of naxalism which includes (a) having a peace dialogue by the affected States, wherever feasible, with naxal groups willing to abjure violence, (b) modernisation and strengthening of the State Police forces, long term deployment of para military forces, intensified intelligence based well-coordinated anti-naxalite operations, (c) focused attention on integrated development of the affected areas and (d) gearing up of public grievances redressal system and creation of Local Resistance Groups. Beside, all naxal affected States have been advised to organize orientation and training programmes for their intelligence and operational branches to understand the pattern and the strategy being adopted by the naxal outfits in ambushing security forces by using IED/landmine explosions.

Since the growth rates of the religious communities in the brief analysis of Report didn't mention that these were unadjusted, all the copies were not distributed. The Report was amended to include both the unadjusted and adjusted rates and made available for sale on 9th September, 2004.
