The rest of the State Governments have no: yet brought the Act into force either because the number of bidi and cigar establishments is negligible in those States or the matter is still under their consideration.

(c) and (d) Under section i (3) of the Act, it is for the State Governments to appoint the date of enforcement of the Act.
