- (b) if so, what are the details thereof and what action has been taken thereon?

Twelve Members of Parliament sent a memorandum to the Prime Minister containing various suggestions for tackling the problems created by the influx of minorities from East Pakistan and suggesting inter alia that the help of all nonaligned countries attending the L'usaka Non-aligned Conference should be sought in this respect.

Government believe that this problem can be solved better through a bilateral approach and that no useful purpose would be served by bringing in third parties.]

SHIFTING OF N.M.D.C. FROM DELHI

*452. SHRI LOKANATH MISRA: SHRI K. C. PANDA. SHRI SUNDAR MANI PATEL:

Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND CHEMICALS AND MINES AND METALS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Offices of the National Mineral Development Corporation are proposed to be shifted from its present location in New Delhi;
- (b) what is the monthly rent being paid now and what would be the additional liability per month when the offices are shifted to a new place; and
- (c) what are the reasons for the shifting?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PETROLEUM AND CHEMICALS, AND MINES AND METALS (SHRI NITI RAJ SINGH CHAUDHARY): (a) There is a proposal to move the headquarters of N.M.D.C. from its present location to another location in Delhi; the question of moving the headquarters out of Delhi, is also under consideration separately.

(b) and (c) The monthly rent being paid for the various premises presently occupied by NMDC offices in New Delhi is Rs. 10,500. The additional

liability on moving to the proposed centralised location would be Rs. 25,548 per month. The present premises are considered insufficient and unsuitable due to increase in the projects assigned to the Corporation. The cost of moving the headquarters out of Delhi is yet to be worked out.
