HASSAN AIRPORT

1288. SHRI M.D. NARAYAN : Will the Minister of TOURISM AND CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state :

(a) whether the work on the proposed Hassan airport is going on as per schedule; if not, reasons for the delay;

(b) the details of the progress made so far on the said airport; and
