(b) The Soviet President assured our President that Soviet leaders were looking into the matter. The Soviet Union have since indicated to us that their latest maps have siarted showing the India-China border with biokcn lines indicating that they do not regard the border as settled.

They have also informed us that they are going lo publish a new map of India in the near future.

(b) The total financial outlay and anticipated receipts during the Fourth Plan period are estimated at Rs. 355.90 crores and Rs. 275.74 crores respectively. When the programme is fully implemented, the production of ONGC is expected to be 5.5 million tonnes per annum during the last year of the Plan (1973-74), as against 3.09 million tonnes in 1968-69 on the eve of the 4th Plan period.

IRBM PROJECT IN CHINA

THE MINISTER OF DEFENCE (SHRI JAGJIVAN RAM): (a) to (c) Government arc aware that China has developed ballistic missiles which have a range of about 2,000 miles, but there is no indication yet of their actual deployment. Though there are press reports icgarding the possibility of China testing an IRBM in the Bay of Bengal, there is no authentic information on this. All developments having a bearing on our security are constantly kept under review. There is no change in the Government's policy regarding nuclear weapons, as explained in the House on a number of occasions.

THE MINISTER OF STATE ON THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY PLANNING AND WORKS, HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI B. S. MURTHY): (a) and (b) A tew limited surveys indicate that there are about 4.5 million blind persons in the country. The percentage of blind persons *vis-a-vis* population of India, USA, and UK is as under—

India	0.9% or over.
U.S. A	0.17%
U.K	0.18%

The major causes of blindness are Cataract, Trachoma, Small-pox, Malnutrition, Hypertension etc.
