THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AND INTERNAL TRADE (SHRI M. R. KRISHNA) : (a) and (b). Government are not aware of the views of the Western India Automobile Association referred to in the question. Government have already decided, in principle, to set up a project in the public sector for the manufacture of passenger cars of a proven foreign design for an annual capacity of 50,000 Nos. In pursuance of this decision, necessary follow up action is now being taken.
