938. SHRI K. L. N. PRASAD: Will the Minister of FOOD AND AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that International Development Association of the World Bank has announced 4.5 crores agricultural credit to
- (b) if so, whether Government have received the credit;
- (c) what are the items on which this loan will be utilised;
- (d) whether Government are considering to help the small farmers from this credit; and
  - (e) if so, to what extent?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FOOD, AGRICULTURE, COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND CO-OPERATION (SHRI ANNASAHEB SHINDE): (a) Yes, Sir.

- (b) The Government of India have concluded negotiations with the World Bank but the agreement has not yet been signed.
- (c) The loan will be utilised for the purchase of 82 agricultural aircrafts, ancillary equipment, and spares and for training of agricultural pilots and engineers.
- (d) and (e) The aerial spraying operations are undertaken over large and contiguous areas including the fields of small farmers who would otherwise have to organise plant coverage for their protection fields individually. It is also a great advantage to have a large and contiguous area covered collectively and simultaneously by aerial spray of pesticides. Thus the aerial spraying operations carried out under the project would help the small farmers substantially though it is not possible to indicate specifically the extent of the benefit.
