- (b) The observations made during these inspections are mainly as follows:
  - (i) Inadequate lighting and poor sanitation in some coaches and portions of some station premises.
  - (ii) Absence of fans and other fittings in some coaches due to vandalism and heft.
  - (iii) Lack of water in toilets of some coaches

- (iv) Need for increasing frequency of inspections including surprise checks of coaches by Supervisors and Officers.
- (v) Need for keeping some booking windows open for longer periods and opening of additional booking windows as necessary to aviod inconvenience to passengers in having to wait for longer periods in queues.
- (vi) Need for introduction of a system of packed wholesome meals and avoiding multiplicity of dishes to reduce pressure on dining cars.
- (vii) Improvement of telecommunication at Ghaziabad station to keep in touch with the position regarding late running of trains.
