**FLOW OF WATER TO PAKISTAN
AFTER EXPIRY OF INDUS WATER
TREATY**

N. G. GORAY :

Will the Minister of IRRIGATION AND POWER be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government's attention has been drawn to the Press Report appearing in 'Sunday Standards,' dated 5th April, 1970 quoting the spokesman of the Government of Punjab disputing the statement made by the Minister of Irrigation and Power in Parliament regarding stoppage of flow of water to Pakistan from the three rivers of Punjab after the expiry of the Indus Water Treaty; and

(b) if so, the reaction of the Government in regard thereto?

THE MINISTER OF IRRIGATION AND POWER (DR. K. L. RAO) : (a) Yes, Sir. However, it has been ascertained that neither have the Punjab

Government issued any statement on the subject of reported continuance of the supply of Indus Waters to Pakistan even after the expiry of the Indus Waters Treaty on 1-4-1970 nor have they contended the factual accuracy of the statement made by me in the Rajya Sabha on 1-4-1970.

**DESPATCH OF EXPLOSIVES

TO OTHER ORDNANCE FACTORIES**

(b) whether it is also a fact that these are being rejected wholesale by the receiving ordnance factories; and

(c) if so, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE (DEFENCE PRODUCTION) IN THE MINISTRY OF DEFENCE (SHRI L. N. MISHRA) : (a) Yes, Sir.
