### Spraying of coca cola on crops as pesticides

# †844. SHRI RAJ MOHINDER SINGH MAJITHA: DR. MURU MANOHAR JOSHI:

#### Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that farmers in certain districts in Andhra Pradesh are spraying coca cola cold drink as a pesticide for the protection of their crops;

(b) if so, the facts in this regard; and

(C) whether it is also a fact that the crops are being protected by the above mentioned spraying method?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI KANTILAL BHURIA): (a) to (c) The Government of Andhra Pradesh has informed that a few farmers in Asifabad Division of Adilabad District in the State have tried to control pests on cotton crop during Kharif, 2004 by spraying coca cola. However, no scientific study has been conducted to confirm the efficacy of coca cola in pest control.
