†[THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY PLANNING AND WORKS, HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (DR. S. CHANDRASEKHAR) :

(a) The posts of Lecturers, Assistant Professors and Associate Professors borne on the strength of Himachal Pradesh Medical College, Jawaharlal Institute of Post-graduate Medical Education and Research, Pondicherry, Lady Hardinge Medical College, New Delhi and Maulana Azad Medical College, New Delhi, are included in the Specialists' grade of the Central Health Service and carry the scale of pay of Rs. 600-40-1000-EB-50-1300 and Non-practising allowance @ 50 per cent of pay subject to a maximum of Rs. 600. Besides, the Assistant Professors get a special pay of Rs. 100/- per month and the Associate Professors get a special pay of Rs. 200 per month. The posts of Assistant Professors and Associate Professors in the Goa Medical College have also recently been included in the Specialists' grade of the C.H.S., but appointments to the Central Health Service are yet to be made. The posts of Lecturers in that College have not yet been included in the Service. The existing scale of pay of the posts of Lecturers in Goa Medical College is Rs. 530-30-650, but on their inclusion in the Specialists' grade of the C.H.S. the scale of pay will be revised to Rs. 600-40-1000-EB-50-1300.

(b) and (c) All posts of Lecturers, Assistant Professors and Associate Professors are included in the Specialists' grade of the C.H.S. Recruitment to all posts included in the Specialists' grade of the C. H.S. is made by direct recruitment on the advice of the Union Public Service Commission.]

# WORLD BANK HELP FOR PUBLIC SECTOR PROJECTS

632. SHRI Z. A. AHMAD : Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state :

(a) whether the Government of India have recently approached the World Bank for help in the setting up of some projects in the Public Sector;

(b) if so, the details of the projects for which help has been sought; and

(c) whether there is any possibility of obtaining help from the World Bank in this respect?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI P. C. SETHI) : (a) to (c) The World Bank has indicated its willingness to consider proposals for loan assistance for fertilizer projects in the Public Sector. Proposals have been made for assistance from the World Bank Group for Cochin Stage II and Nangal Expansion Projects. These proposals are under consideration of the Bank. After completion of the consideration of the proposals, the Bank may appraise the projects for enabling them to decide whether they would be able to finance these projects.

# DEARTH OF QUALIFIED TEACHERS IN MEDICAL COLLEGES

Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY PLANNING AND WORKS, HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state :

(a) whether it is a fact that the All India Medical Association has opposed the opening of new medical colleges due to dearth of qualified and efficient teachers; and

(b) if so, what steps are being proposed to provide qualified and efficient teachers?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY PLANNING AND WORKS, HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (DR. S. CHANDRASEKHAR) : (a) Yes.

(b) To encourage Medical and Dental graduates to take up advanced studies

in different Post-Graduate disciplines so as to meet the demand for teachers and specialists in the medical colleges, the Government of India has a Scholarship Scheme. 377 scholarships are awarded annually under two Schemes, that is, 300 scholarship under the All India Scholarships Scheme and 77 under the Delhi Hospital Scholarships Scheme.

Facilities for Post-Graduate Medical Education have been and are being increased by :

(i) maintenance and development of the three existing Post-Graduate Institutes of Medical Education and Research at New Delhi, Chandigarh and Pondicherry;

(ii) grant of financial assistance to States for opening Post-Graduate departments in Medical Colleges. This also includes assistance for awarding stipends to Post-Graduate students in these departments.

#### OIL IN JAMMU AND KASHMIR

#### TELEPHONE OPERATORS IN GOVERNMENT HOSPITALS IN DELHI

635. SHRI GANESHI LAL CHAUDHARY : Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY PLANNING AND WORKS, HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state :

(a) whether it is a fact that there is a disparity in the average hours of duty per week required to be performed by

the Telephone Operators of the different Central Government hospitals in New Delhi/Delhi;

(b) if so, what are the reasons therefor; and

(c) what are the average hours of duty a telephone operator is required to perform per week in these hospitals?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY PLANNING AND WORKS, HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (DR. S. CHANDRASEKHAR) : (a) to (c) At the Willingdon Hospital there are at present 5 telephone clerks, who work in 4 shifts round the clock. Each of them works 36 hours a week on the average.

At the Safdarjang Hospital there are two boards—one PABX and the other '102' for Ambulance Service. 11 Telephone Operators including one leave-reserve work in 4 shifts as under :

1st Shift . . .	7 A.M.	12 NOON
2nd Shift . . .	12 NOON	5 P.M.
3rd Shift . . .	5 P.M.	9 P.M.
4th Shift . . .	9 P.M.	7 A.M.

Average duty hours of a telephone operator in a week in the Safdarjang Hospital comes to 33.6 hours. Each Operator gets 7.5 off days in a month in lieu of Sundays and gazetted holidays. The night-shift of 10 hours is fixed by mutual understanding with the operators.

8 operators are always on duty on two boards and 3 are meant for giving them off days and as reliefs during casual and regular leave.

The duty hours are dependent upon the work load on the boards and the exigencies of service in the respective hospitals.
