WHOLESALE FOODGRAIN TRADE BY FOOD CORPORATION OF INDIA

(d) if so, the names thereof and the reasons advanced by them?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FOOD, AGRICULTURE, COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND COOPERATION (SHRI ANNASHEB SHINDE) :

(a) to (d) Government are carrying on a considerable volume of wholesale trade in major foodgrains through public agencies. Complete take over of wholesale trade of all foodgrains is not contemplated at present. So far, the State Governments of Bihar, Kerala, Rajasthan, Orissa, Madhya Pradesh, Uttar Pradesh and West Bengal have entrusted the Food Corporation of India with the wholesale trade in foodgrains to a limited extent. In addition to the Food Corporation of India, the State Governments are utilising their own machinery and Cooperatives as far as possible. Private trade agencies are also operating in most of the States.
