- (a) whether in compliance of the direction of Hon'ble High Court of Calcutta, a joint meeting between the representatives of Government of India and the Covernment of West Bengal was held on 21.3.99 on the crossion problem by Ganga in Malda and Murshidabad in West Bengal;
- (b) whether as per the decision taken in the same meeting, Government was required to execute seven schemes costing Rs. 1.30 crores; and

THE MINISTER OF WATER RESOURCES (SHRI ARIUN SETHI): (a) to (c) In compliance of the Hon'ble High Court of Calcutta, a joint meeting between the representatives of Government of India and the Government of West Bengal

was held on 21.9.99 at New Delhi on the erosion problem by Ganga in Malda and Murshidabad in West Bengal. As jointly decided during the meeting, the Central Government would be required to undertake seven schemes under short term measures at an estimated cost of Rs. 130 crore through Farakka Barrage Project Authority. The Farakka Barrage Project Authority has already undertaken anti-erosion works of river Ganga in critical reaches through bank protection.
