TEACHING OF PUNJABI IN DELHI

965. SHRI GURUMUKH SINGH MUSAFIR: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that Punjabi Sahit Sabha, New Delhi addressed a communication to the Commissioner for Linguistic Minorities. Allahabad, regarding the teaching of Punjabi in Delhi State; and

(b) if so, the details of the communication and the action taken thereon?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI VIDYA CHARAN SHUKLA): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) The following two issues have been raised in the communication:

(i) In spite of declared policy the Delhi Administration have not provided for teaching of Punjabi wherever there are twelve students in classes from sixth to ninth.

(ii) Delhi Administration have not earnestly implemented the three-language formula.

The communication was forwarded by the Commissioner for Linguistic Minorities on 5th May to the Delhi Administration and is now receiving attention of the Delhi Administration.

EXPANSION OF PAI AM AIRPORT
