Atrocities against Women in Kerala

SHRI K. CHANDRAN PILLAI:†

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the National Commission for Women has received any complaints regarding cases of atrocities against women from Kerala;
 - (b) if so, the details thereof, incident-wise; and
 - (c) the details of the action taken thereon?

THE MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI ARJUN SINGH): (a) No, Sir.

(b) and (c) Do not arise.

SHRI K. CHANDRAN PILLAI: Sir, if Mr. Chairman permits, I would like to put a point to the hon. Minister though the answer is 'no'. The recent developments in our State are related to atrocities on women specifically. One sex scandal is under discussion over there in a big way; two nuns and one priest were also attacked by the BJP followers. Regarding that, my question is: Is there any report received by the Government from the National Commission for Women? If not, is there any action initiated by the Government, *suo motu?* That is what I wanted to know.
