(c) The slight fall in the value of exports of unmanufactured tobacco has been due to the over-production and accumulation of lower grades of Flue Cured Virginia Tobacco during 1968-69.

There has been progressive decline in exports of tobacco products for the following

- (i) Local production and high import duties in consuming countries and
- (ii) Difficulty in getting consumer acceptance due to brand consciousness.
