I. T. O.'s TRAINING INSTITUTE AT NAGPUR

1284. SHRI T. G. DESHMUKH : SHRI N. P. CHAUDHARI :

Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state :

(a) whether it is fact that the Training Institute for Income Tax Officers at Nagpur is proposed to be shifted to Hyderabad or to any other place outside Nagpur; and

(b) is so, the reasons therefor ?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI P. C. SETHI) : (a) Yes, Sir. It has been decided to shift the Indian Revenue Service (Direct Taxes) Staff College, Nagpur to Hyderabad.

(b) The reasons for the decision are :—

(i) Hyderabad is a more suitable location from the point of view of climate.

(ii) As the Administrative staff College is located at Hyderabad, the Income-tax probationers will have the advantage of attending lectures given by distinguished visitors at the staff College.

(iii) The facilities for practical training at Hyderabad are better than those at Nagpur.

(iv) Non-availability of suitable land at Nagpur at the relevant time.
