EXCAVATION WORK IN CHANDIGARH

*79. SHRI BABUBHAI M. CHINAI : Will the Minister of EDUCATION AND YOUTH SERVICES be pleased to state whether there is any proposal under the consideration of the Archaeological Survey of India to undertake excavation work in Chandigarh where the Harappan culture has recently been discovered?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION AND YOUTH SERVICES (SHRIMATI JAHANARA JAIPAL SINGH) : At the present stage the Archaeological Survey of India has no proposal to undertake excavation at Chandigarh. The Survey, however, had advised the Department of Ancient Indian Culture and Archaeology, University of Punjab, to undertake exploration of the unbuilt area at the back of the site of discovery for which the survey can extend technical assistance.

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION AND YOUTH SERVICES (SHRIMATI JAHANARA JAIPAL SINGH) : (a) to (b) : The Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Sites and Remains Act 1958 was extended to the territory of Pondicherry with effect from the 1st October, 1963. Eight monuments were taken over *de facto* and protected by the Archaeological Survey of India. Five of these are temples.

U.G.C. PAY SCALES FOR PROFESSORS, LECTURERS, ETC., IN MYSORE COLLEGES

*82. **SHRI MUKLA GOVINDA REDDY:** Will the Minister of **EDUCATION AND YOUTH SERVICES** be pleased to state :

(a) the present U.G.C. scales of pay and allowances of lecturers, assistant professors, readers and professors in the three Universities of Mysore State;

(b) whether the same scales of pay have been given to the lecturers, assistant professors, readers and professors in the (i) Government colleges in Bangalore and in other parts of Mysore State; (ii) in private colleges in Bangalore and in other parts of Mysore State;

(c) whether Government's attention has been drawn to the fact that the Lecturers in Government colleges in Mysore stagnate in the same scale of pay, even though they have put in more than 15 years of service;

(d) whether any steps are being taken to give higher grades to such Lecturers who have put in more than 15 years of service; and

(e) what steps Government propose to take to bring the scales of pay of lecturers in Government colleges at par with their counterparts in the Universities?

THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION AND YOUTH SERVICES (PROF. V. K. R. V. RAO) : (a) to (e). A statement is laid on the Table of the Sabha.

(a) All the three Universities in Mysore State have been permitted to adopt the following salary scales framed by the Government of India on the recommendations of the University Grants Commission :

Professors	Rs. 1100-50-1300-60-1600
Readers	Rs. 700-50-1250
Lecturers	Rs. 400-40-800-50-950.

One-third of the posts of Professors are in the scale of Rs. 1600-100-1800. There is no post of Assistant Professor. In addition the teachers are paid Dearness Allowance at State Government rates.

(b) The scales granted to the various categories of teachers in both the Government/private colleges of Bangalore and other parts of the Mysore State are indicated below :

Professor-cum-Principal	Rs. 600-40-1000 plus special pay of Rs. 100 p.m.
Professor	Rs. 400-30-700-40-900
Reader-cum-Principal	Rs. 400-30-640-40-800 plus special pay of Rs. 100 p.m.
Reader	Rs. 400-30-640-40-800
Lecturer	Rs. 300-25-600.

(c) The State Government is reported to be seized of this question.

(d) The matter is under consideration of the Government of Mysore.

(e) The State Government does not propose to bring the pay scales of lecturers in Government colleges which are under-graduate colleges, on par with their counterparts in the Universities.
