

(b) The Central Government draws up and implements tourism schemes not on a State wise basis but having regard to the actual or potential attraction of a place for tourists. During the Fourth Plan, it is proposed to provide additional facilities at Madras, Mahabalipuram and Madurai.

TRANSFER OF FAZILKA TO HARYANA

*731. SHRI SULTAN SINGH : Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state :

(a) whether the Central Government have taken any steps to transfer the Fazilka area in Punjab to Haryana in accordance with their decision on Chandigarh;

(b) if so, the details thereof; and

(c) the time by when it will be transferred to Haryana?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI K. C. PANT) : (a) to (c) As stated in the press communique issued on 29th January, 1970 the transfer of the part of Fazilka tehsil to Haryana State will be effected simultaneously with the transfers to be decided upon on the recommendations of the Commission to be appointed to go into the claims and counter-claims for readjustment of the existing inter-State boundaries of Punjab, Haryana and Himachal Pradesh. It is not possible to indicate the time by which these processes would be completed.

FORMATION OF NEW LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY IN WEST BENGAL

(a) whether it is a fact that the West Bengal Legislative Assembly has been dissolved;

(b) whether Government have taken any decision about the future course of action to be taken in forming a new legislature in the State; and

(c) whether the Governor's report has made any suggestion in this regard if so, the details thereof and Government's decision thereon?
