THE MINISTER OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIF S. AND SHIPPING AND TRANSPORT (SHRI K. RAGHU RAMAIAH): a) and (b) It is not the policy of the (iovt. of India to meet the cost of electrifk ition from their funds. The lighting arrange nents, if and when considered necessap, has to be made by the Municipal Boai i or the local authority

concerned. The Govt, of India however meet the cost of fixtures like lamp posts and cable ducts since they have to be designed along with the bridge. Accordingly the Govt, of India have met the cost of only the fixtures i.e. the lamp posts fixed on the Jawahar Setu.

An estimate amounting to Rs. 4.30.909/-for the construction of ramps was sanctioned by the Govt, of India in September, 1969.
