#### **KEY PUNCH OPERATORS**

1592. SHRI M. V. BHADRAM: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that a large number of persons were appointed in the office of the Registrar General of India against the posts of Key Punch Operators in the scale of Rs. 110—180 plus a special pay of Rs. 15/- p.m.;
- (b) if so, how many Key Punch Operators have been denied the Special Pay guaranteed in the appointment order;
- (c) whether it is a fact that they are being forced to work as Assistant Compilers without any official order and if so, on what grounds; and
- (d) whether Government have received letters from M.Ps. or representations from the employees in this regard and if so, what steps are being taken in the matter?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI K. S. RAMASWAMY): (a) to (d) The number of persons appointed as Key Punch Operators and still working in that capacity is 26. As the permanent staffing pattern of the R.G's. office did not provide for a separate category of Key Punch Operators but will have only Assistant Compilers, at one stage a scheme for absorbing the temporary Key Punch Operators in the category of the Assistant Compilers was contemplated. In that process, six Key Punch Operators had been assigned duties of Assistant Compilers and an equal number of Assistant Compilers were given the opportunity to work on the Key Punch

machines under the orders of the Registrar General. During the period the operators were working as Assistant Compilers they were not granted any special pay. There were representations against this from the Key Punch Operators and a letter was also received from a Member of Parliament. The matter was reviewed and a decision has been taken to keep the two categories separate and all the Key Punch Operators have been put back on the machine job.

## Q.UASI-PERMANENCY OF KEY PUNCH OPERATORS

1593. SHRI M. V. BHADRAM: Will the PRIME MINISTER be peased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that a statutory rule exists under which temporary Govern ment servants who have rendered 3 years service are to be made quasi-permanent; and
- (b) whether it is a fact that a large number of Key Punch Operators in the office of the Registrar General of India have not been made quasi-permanent even after 8 to 10 years of service whereas Assistant Compilers who have rendered less service have been made quasi-permanent and if so, the reasons therefor?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI K. S. RAMASWAMY): (a) There is a provision in the rules to the effect that an employee who has rendered continuous temporary service for three years or more shall be deemed to be in quasi-permanent service, if the; appointing authority makes a declaration t<i that effect.

(b) There had been some delay in issuing the quasi-permanency declarations in respect of the Key Punch Operators ami also Assistant Compilers mainly because the question of framing recruitment rules and absorbing the former in the grade of Assistant Compilers remained under consideration, it has now been decided that the two categories should be kept distinct, but such of the Key Punch Operators who wish to come over to the grade of Assistant Compilers would have the option to do

so. Action to dec lare the Key Punch Operators and the AJ istant Compilers as quasipermanent has all o been taken in hand and the necessary det larations are being issued as and when th< preliminaries are completed. In the ca>3 of some Assistant Compilers, where th I preliminaries had been completed, the declarations have been issued.
