The area actually acquired during the last three years is being ascertained and will be laid on the Table of the Sabha.

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PETROLEUM AND CHEMICALS AND MINES AND AND METALS (SHRI D. R. CHA-VAN): (a) Yes. The Government of India have appointed a Drugs Prices Review Board on the 28th July, 1970.

STATE BANK SCHEME FOR SMALL SCALE IN JUSTRIALISTS

- 1677. SHRI K. L. N. PRASAD: Will the Mir ster of FINANCE be pleased to state;
- (a) whether it is a fact that the State Bank of India has decided to start a scheme to provide credit facilities to Small-Scale Industrialists to carry out expansion programmes; and
- (b) if so, what are the main features of the scheme?

THE MINISTER OF REVENUE AND EXPENDITURE (SHRI VIDYA CHARAN SHUKLA): (a) and (b) The State Bank of India has not formulated any separate scheme to finance the expansion programme of small scale industries. However, the bank is already providing cre lit facilities to small scale industries un ler its liberalised scheme, which cover credit requirements for | of this schemes; and

expansion programme also. Comprehensive credit facilities to meet working tapital as well as term loan requirements are provided by the bank. Term loans are provided by the bank for the acquisition of fixed assets such as land, building and plant and machinery. While the normal margins in respect of land and buildings and machinery are 33.1/3% and 25% respectively, a reduced margin of 25% is agreed to for construction of sheds in industrial estates. The loans are normally repayable in suitable instal-ments over a period of 7 to 10 years. The rate of interest on these loans is 9% per annum.

AGREEMENT FOR RE-PAYMENT OF LOANS' TO JAPAN

1678. SHRI K. L. N. PRASAD: Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the Government of Japan have recently agreed to the request of the Government of India to defer the repayment of Indian loans to Japan; and
- (b) whether any agreement has been signed recently in this regard and if so, what are the terms and other details of the agreement?

THE MINISTER OF REVENUE AND EXPENDITURE (SHRI VIDYA CHARAN SHUKLA): (a) and (b) Yes Sir. Four Agreements totalling Rs. 19.06 crores (\$25.41 million) were signed on the 30th July, 1970.

The agreements envisage rescheduling of part of earlier Yen Credits which are due for repayment during 1970-71. The agreements provide for repayment in 12 years, including 3 years' grace, and carry interest at 4% per annum.
