(ग) पांच ऐसे देश हैं, जिन्हें भारत सरकार ने मान्यता नहीं दी है, लेकिन जिन के भारत के साथ व्यापार सम्बन्ध हैं। जिन देशों के साथ भारत सरकार के राजनयिक सम्बन्ध तो नहीं हैं, लेकिन व्यापार-सम्बन्ध हैं उनको संख्या चौबीस है।

[THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI SURMNDRA PAL SINGH): (a) There are no member countries of U.N.O., which have not been accorded diplomatic recognition by the Government of India. Government of India, however, does not recognise the Nationalist Government of China. The number of countries of the U.N.O. with which the Government of India has no diplomatic relations at ambassadorial level is nineteen.

(b) Does not arise.

(c) There are five countries which have not been recognised by the Government of India but which have trade relations with India. The number of countries with which the Government of India does not have diplomatic relations but has trade relations is twentyfour.]
