ANNASATIEB SHINDE): (a) and (b) A Project report pre pared by the Cochin Port Trust was re ceived in the Ministry in January, 1970. The project envisages provision of a wharf wall, jetty, slipwayj workshop and auction hall to meet the requirements of about sixty medium and large fishing vessels, to gether with loading and unloading, main tenance and other related shore facilities.

(c) The Project is estimated to cost about Rs. 300 lakhs.

(d) The Project report is under examination. Clarification of certain points has been obtained from the State Government. Technical aspects of the designs and estimates are being examined in consultation with the Ministry of Transport and Shipping. Discussions have also been held recently with the authorities of Cochin Port Trust and the State Govt. The question of sanctioning the Project will be considered in consultation with the Ministry of Finance as as soon as the examination of details of the Project is completed.
