†[THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF LAW AND IN THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL WELFARE (SHRI JAGANNATH RAO) : (a) In the current financial year the nutrition scheme for children in the age group of 0-3 years is proposed to be introduced in the tribal areas and the urban slum areas, particularly of capital cities. The formal Government sanction has already been communicated to the State Governments and Union Territories. The programme has been started in a modest way in some tribal areas of Madhya Pradesh and slum areas of Calcutta city. It is expected that it will be introduced in other parts of the country also shortly.

KRISHNA) (a) to (c) The main recommendations of the Delegation given in the report relate to placing the small scale industries development programme on a statutory basis, widening the scope of the small scale industries programme to include small service units and small commercial units, strengthening of the Small Scale Industries Development Organisation, development of ancillary industries, modernisation of small scale industries and development of exports of the small scale sector. These recommendations are under examination by the Government alongwith those of the Administrative Reforms Commission which cover similar ground.
