PANT) : (a) The Institute of Ap-ied Manpower Research brought out in ecember. 1969. a working paper "Employent Outlook for Engineers 1969—79". ic Institute have circulated this Working iper amongst all the concerned Ministries d other agencies and have invited their mments on it. The paper would be re-amined by the Institute in the light of sse comments. In its present form, irefore, the working paper cannot be nsidered to be final.

I lie working paper attempts an estimate ul ihe supply of and demand for engineers during the Fourth and Fifth Plan pei These estimates are based on a numh assumptions regarding the rate of growth of the economy during the Fourth and Fifth Plan periods, the scale of future admissions to the engineering institutions and the pattern of engineering employment. Based on these assumptions, if has I observed in the paper that there will be i surplus ul engineers of the order of one lakh in 1973-74. An overall balance between supply of and demand for engineer, is. however, likely to be reached by 1978-79. The paper emphasises a very important qualification to these Ii has been assumed in conclusions. the paper that the pattern of engineering employment would continue to be what it was till 1964. On the other hand, efforts are being taken to explore employment opportunities for engineers in various fields such as small scale industries, marketing, management. consultancy etc. sales, If these trends diversify the pattern of engineering employment, the surplus of engineers worked out in the paper may burn out to be exaggerated.

(b) The Government initiated in May. 1968. a number of measures to create additional employment opportunities for engineers. The implementation of these measures by the Central Ministries and Slate Governments is being closely reviewed. A statement enumerating the progress made so far by the Central Ministries and State Governments in implementing these measures was laid on the Table of the House in answer to Unslarred Question No. 420 on the 4th August. 1970.
