

PENSION TO JAWANS OF TERRITORIAL ARMY

*40g. SHRI SURAJ PRASAD: Will the Minister of DEFENCE be pleased to state :

fa) whether Jawans of the Territorial Army are also given pensions by Government on the expiry of their term of set vice as in the case of the regular Army;

(b) if so, what are the rates of pension granted to various ranki from the soldiers to the officers in the Territorial Army; and

(c) if the reply to pari (a.) above, be he negative the reasons therefor and > steps are be'ng taken by Govern ment in this regard?]

रक्षा मंत्री (श्री जगजीवन राम) : (क) जी नहीं ।

(ख) प्रश्न नहीं उठता ।

(ग) प्रादेशिक सेना पूर्णकालिक वृत्तिका प्राप्त करने के लिए अभिप्रेत नहीं है । मुख्यतः वह उन लोगों के लिए अभिप्रेत है जो पहले से रोजगार सहित हैं; और जो किसी अयाती स्थिति में देश की सेवा कर पाने के उद्देश्य से सैनिक प्रशिक्षण पाने के लिए फालतु समय निकाल सकते हैं । चूंकि एक प्रमोच अवधि के लिए निरन्तर सेवा के पश्चात् ही नियमित सेवा सेविवर्ग को सेव निवृत्ति पेन्शन प्रदान की जाती है, प्रादेशिक सेना के सेविवर्ग को पेन्शन का अधिकारी नहीं बनाया गया । तदपि कुल समग्रीकृत सेवा की अवधि से संबंध वह अन्तिम उपदान के अधिकारी हैं ।

THE MINISTER OF DEFENCE (SHRI JAGJIVAN RAM): (a) No, Sir.

(b) Does not arise.

(c) The Territorial Army is not intended to provide a full time career. It is primarily meant for persons who are in employment and can devote their spare time for military training with the object of serving the country in an emergency. As retiring pension to regular Army personnel is granted only after rendering a certain period of continuous service, personnel of the Territorial Army have made eligible for pension. They

are, however entitled to a terminal gratuity related to the length of aggregate embodied service.]

CANAL HEADWORKS IN PUNJAB AND HARYANA

*410. SHRI SULTAN SINGH: Will the Minister of IRRIGATION AND POWER be pleased to state :

(a) the names of canal headwork in Punjab and Haryana ;

(b) whether the Central Government propose to exercise some control over these headworks; and

(c) if not, which Government is controlling these headwork? at pi

THE MINISTER OF IRRIGATION AND POWERS (DR. K. L. RAO) : (a) Nangal, Rupar, Harike, Ferozepur, Madhopur and Tajewala.

(b) and (c) The Madhopur headwork is under the control of Punjab Government. The Tajewala headwork is under the control of Haryana Government. According to Section 79(1) of the Punjab Reorganisation Act, 1966 the Central Government was empowered to constitute a Board, called the Bhakra Management Board for the administration, maintenance and operation of certain works including the four Headworks of Nangal, Rupar, Harike & Ferozepur. The control of Rupar, Harike and Ferozepur headworks has, however, not been handed over by the Punjab Government so far to the Bhakra Management Board.
