The Study Group, among other things, has suggested definite Pilot Projects to be taken up in ihe field of elementary education!. The report has recently been considered by the Conferences of Education Secretaries and Directors of Education/ Public Instruction.

The State Governments will be requested to initiate tha Projects after the proposals have been cleared with the Ministry of Finance and Planning Commission.
