## STRENGTHENING OF DISTRICT ADMINIS-TRATION

## -464. SHRI S. D. M1SRA:

CHAUOHARY A. MOHA-MMAD: SHR1 MAHAVIR TYAGI v SHRI 11. K. KAUL: SHRI NAWAL KISHORE: SHRI GANESHI LAL CHAUDHARY:

Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state the steps taken or being taken for stn ngthening the district administrations n pursuance of the discussions held b> her on 23rd May, 1970 with the Chief Ministers of various States in connection with communal tension in certain parts pf the country?

THE MINUTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRV OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI RAM NIWAS MIRDHA): In

the course of i iformal discussions with some of the Chief Ministers on May 23, 1970 regarding the communal, situation, there wis general agreement on the need to strengthen the district administration. The measures suggested for the consk eration of the State Governments i iclude the following:

- (i) In th: communally sensitive areas, tested officers known for their sound jude ment, alertness and ability to de;il effectively with communal situations, should be posted and such di trict postings should be made more .ttractive.
- (ii) Adeq late staffing of the districts, subdi\ isions and police stations concerned slould be ensured.
- (iii) Adequate arrangements for the collection of intelligence, its prompt assessment and utilisation should be m ide.
- (iv) Adequate alrmed police reserves should be so located that these areas can ol tain reinforcements without delay. The State Governments are examinirj these suggestions.

## INDIA OFFICE LIBRARY

\*465. SHRI MAHAVIR TYAGI : SHRI S. D. MISRA: SHRI B. K. KAUL:

Will the Minister of EDUCATION AND YOUTH SERVICES be pleased to state:

- (a) the progress that has been made in acquiring the India Office Library in London; and
- (b) what are the hurdles even now which stand in the way of the acquisition and what arc ihe prospects of their solution?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION AND YOUTH SERVICES (SHRI A. K. KISKU): (a) and (b) Efforts have been continuously made by the Government of India with the Government of U.K. for acquiring the contents of India Office Library, London. A draft agreement for arbitration is under discussion with the Government of U.K. One main reason for the delay is the prolonged discussion with the Government of U.K. about the basis on which a settlement can be made.

## MAHANADI AS A NATIONAL WATERWAY

- \*466. SHRI N. G. GORAY; WUI the Minister of PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS AND SHIPPING AND TRANSPORT be pleased to state:
- (a) whether it is a fact that the Central Inland Water Transport Committee has suggested that Mahanadi in Orissa be declared a National Waterway;
- (b) if so. whether Government have accepted the said- suggestion; and
  - (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS AND SHIPPING AND TRANSPORT (SHRI RAGHURAMAIAH) : (a) No, Sir. The Government have not yet received the recommendations of the Inland Water Transport Committee in respect of Orissa.
