THE MINISTER OF TOURISM AND CIVIL AVIATION (DR. KARAN SINGH): (a) and (b) The project has been approved in principle and, Rs. 9,07,925 have already been sanctioned for acquisition of land. The State Government has initiated proceedings for this purpose. Thereafter, other works will be taken in hand to the extent resources can be made available within the Fourth Plan ceiling. It is not possible, at this stage, to give the date on which the air port will be commissioned.

STEPS TO COUNTER COMMUNALISM

In that letter she impressed upon them the urgent need for utmost vigilance and strong action on the part of the administration to curb the forces that encourage communalism.
