

and video facilities; and (c) offering regular short term advanced courses on upcoming research areas;

(iv) providing a forum for exchanging ideas and establishing linkage among scientists of leading institutions and industry working in similar areas by framing collaborative R&D proposals; and

(v) offering fellowships for helping faculty and scholars from less endowed institutions.

(c) The research output of the center will help in establishing linkage with industry for their benefit. Many industries in India including BHEL, TISCO, Tata Motors, ISRO, CMC have been using conventional methodologies in the areas of vision, pattern recognition, machine learning etc. Soft computing technologies will enhance their product quality and process efficiency to achieve better competitiveness; thereby demonstrating the significant promises of the center for industrial development. In this context, their industries and laboratories have already approached ISI for getting its expertise in the above-mentioned fields.

#### **Setting up of Statistical Commission**

1588. SHRI K. RAMA MOHANA RAO: Will the Minister of STATISTICS AND PROGRAMME IMPLEMENTATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government are thinking of bringing legislation to set up statistical commission;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether it is also a fact that Government are thinking of issuing an administrative order to set up the Commission rather than bringing a Bill before Parliament; and

(d) if so, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF STATISTICS AND PROGRAMME IMPLEMENTATION (SHRI OSCAR FERNANDES): (a) to (d) A proposal to set up a national Statistical Commission by an administrative order is under consideration of Government. Such a measure will enable the Commission to start its activities as soon as possible. It is proposed that this body will bring forward a draft legislation taking into

account a Bill introduced earlier in Parliament on the matter as also the situation obbjining in other countries and the ground realities of the emerging requirements of the Nation.
