Written Answers

- (a) whether Delhi is facing an acute shortage of steel affecting adversely the construction work both in the public and private spheres;
- (b) if so, what are the reasons for the shortage; and
- (c) what steps Government have taken to meet the shortage of steel in the Capital?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF STEEL AND HEAVY ENGINEERING (SHRI K. C. PANT): (a) Yes, Sir. Of late some shortage of constructional steel has been reported in Delhi State.

- (b) Constructional steel, *i.e.*, bars and rods, light structurals, etc., are pro duced by main producers as well as re-rollers, who work on billets obtained from the main plants. One of the main suppliers of constructional steel and billets is Durgapur Steel Plant, whose production has suffered a con tinuous set back on account of various difficulties including labour troubles. Combined with the shortfall in availability there has been an increase in demand also due to the recovery of the economy from recession.
- (c) Supplies through producers' stock yards are being augmented. In respect of specific cases of short supply brought to Government's notice, J. P. C. has been asked to arrange expeditious supply.

- (b) The names of the Central Industrial Projects proposed to be set up during the Fourth Plan are given on pages 253-260 of the Draft Fourth Five Year Plan Report. So far as the setting up of new industrial projects in Maharashtra in the private sector is concerned, this is primarily left to the initiative of private entrepreneurs. However, in licensing new units in the private sector, various technoeconomic considerations including the need *to* promote balanced regional development are given due consideration.
- (c) and (d) The Government of Maharashtra have requested the location of two public sector projects for the manufacture of seamless tubes and gas cylinders in that State. These requests will be considered along with similar requests received from other States at the time location for these projects are finalised, after a decision regarding implementation of these projects is taken.,
